True two year old heifers. Calving should start around middle of October. T&T Farms has been a closed herd for the past 15 years with the exception of new bulls. We keep our own replacement heifers each year and focus on buying bulls with good genetic quality. Because of these practices we've seen improvements in our calf crop each year. We try to run a 70 day calving season. We cull hard and sell any open cows. Because of this management practice, the reproductive traits in our females have improved each year. At T&T Farms we focus on a forage-based nutrition program for our cattle consisting of mixed summer grasses and ryegrass in the winter. Supplemental feeding is done only when the weather and grass conditions dictate it necessary. Calves are fed a grain ration for short time during weaning and are transitioned to grass afterwards. These heifers should not fall off after calving and will fit right into your grazing practices at home. We also focus on an extensive mineral program for all cattle. The cattle in our herd are on a strict modified-live vaccination program which includes vaccines for IBR-BVD, Hardjo bovis, lepto, and clostridia. All cows are given one round of vaccines a year with de-wormer as needed. Calves are given two rounds of modified-live IBR-BVD and clostridia vaccine. These heifers are up-to-date on their shots and healthy. As a certified BQA producer all cattle are handled according to Beef Quality Assurance standards and a selected for a more docile cowherd and calf crop. Heifers are bred to low birth weight Angus bulls from Tanner Farms by Tour of Duty and Final Answer 0035. T&T Farms bred our own replacement heifers to these bulls last year and had no problems during the calving season.

We have been in the commercial cattle business since 1970 and have chosen seedstock that work well for us in the heavy, black soils of Noxubee County and the hot summers and high humidity of Pearl River County. These heifers are 7/8 Brangus and the other 1/8 is either Charolais or Hereford. The exception is #105, she is 1/2 Brangus, 1/4 Hereford and 1/4 Brahman. Her dam is a Tigerstripe. They are the product of 18 years of using calving ease and high growth EPDs as part of our bull selection criteria. Of the last 1,080 cows and heifers that have calved on our ranch, we have only assisted with 2 deliveries – one was backwards and the other was out of an obese heifer (that was too lazy to push). Pregnancy checked on 8/5/17. Heifers are up-to-date on all recommended by veterinarian. Heifers have also been vaccinated for Brucellosis and Scour Guard. Heifers have been de-wormed. Heifers are bred to low birth weight, calving ease, Town Creek Brangus bulls.
